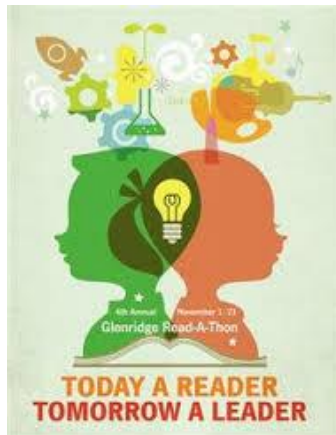

Tablet Service

Who can borrow a tablet?

All TKU students and faculty members and staff may borrow a tablet from the main library.

When, where and for how long can I borrow a tablet?

Tablets are available between the hours of 8:20 AM and 18:00 PM Monday through Friday from the **Non-book Circulation Desk at 5th floor** of the Main library.

Tablets can be borrowed for 7 days. Renewals are not permitted.

Tablets must be returned during service hours on time at the same desk where they were borrowed.

The overdue fine will be NT\$50 per day from the first day overdue.

Who is responsible for damage or theft?

The person who checked out the tablet is responsible for returning the tablet in good condition. In case of damage, theft or loss, the user will be charged the cost of maintenance or full replacement.

2 Ways get the information about new arrivals of library collections

1. RSS Subscription

What is RSS?

RSS stands for "Really Simple Syndication". it allows you to identify the content you like and have it delivered directly to you. When you "subscribe" to a RSS feed, the latest news and additions to the website will be delivered directly to you.
